When Herod threw Peter in jail, with the intent of having him killed, the early church prayed for him without ceasing. An angel of the Lord miraculously saved Peter




out of prison, and the soldiers guarding him were killed. God answered the prayers of the saints and led Peter to safety. 23. Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.

You can read about it in Acts chapter 12.

King Saul was sleeping in a cave that was inhabited by David and his men. David would not lay his hand on the Lord's anointed, but did cut off a portion of Saul's robe. After King Saul awoke and walked a safe distance away, David called to him and showed how he could have killed him. Saul repented

and stopped pursuing David for a season. God will always protect you, if you put your trust in Him.



24. When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.
